Guglielmo Tamburrini (PhD in Philosophy 1987, Columbia University) is Philosophy of Science and Technology Professor at Università di Napoli Federico II in Italy. His current research interests mainly concern ELSE (Ethical, Legal, and SocioEconomic) issues arising in the context of human-computer and human-robot interactions, in addition to epistemology and methodology of AI and robotics; acted as coordinator of the first European project on the ethics of robotics (2005-2008); scientific/ethics adviser in various European research projects. Visiting Scholar in 2009-10 at ZIF (Zentrum für Interdisziplinäre Forschung, Universität Bielefeld, Germany); was awarded the Giulio Preti International Prize in 2014 by the Regional Parliament of Tuscany for research and teaching activities on ethical and social implications of ICT and robotics. Currently member of ICRAC (International Committee for Robot Arms Control) and Scientific Board member of USPID (Unione degli Scienziati per il Disarmo).
