I work in the cardiac surgery division where I am dedicated to the ward activity, the preoperative work-up and postoperative care of patients with valvulopathies and coronary artery disease undergoing cardiac surgery.

In addition, I actively attend the interventional cardiology cath lab, where as first operator, I regularly perform coronary angiographies and percutaneous coronary interventions of easy and intermediate complexity with standby supervision, also guided by physiology and intravascular imaging, both from radial and femoral access. As second operator, I take part in structural interventional procedures, mainly transcatheter aortic valve implantation (TAVI), including valve-in-valve interventions, but also percutaneous edge-to-edge mitral valve repair, percutaneous closure of patent foramen ovale, atrial septal defect and left atrial appendage, also with the attention to procedural planning.

During the fellowship I had the opportunity to actively attend the cardiology, internal medicine and cardiac surgery wards and sub-intensive care units, cardiology intensive care unit and cardiology outpatient clinics, learning to manage the main cardiology diseases both in the acute and chronic setting. I developed a particular interest in interventional cardiology and regularly participated in coronary and structural interventional procedures performed by Professor Di Mario and his team, having taken part in several complex revascularisation procedures of chronic total coronary occlusions, treatment of bifurcations, diffuse and calcific lesions, guided by the use of intracoronary imaging techniques (IVUS and OCT) and with the usual use of physiological assessment techniques (iFR/FFR/IMR/CMR). I had the opportunity also to be present during many structural interventions. I was also responsible in supporting patients' screening, data collection and follow-up in multiple controlled studies.
