Professor Stan Metcalfe is Professor Emeritus at the University of Manchester and a visiting Fellowship in the Centre for Business Research at Cambridge University, and has held Visiting Professorships at the University of Queensland and Curtin University, Western Australia. He was the Haydn Williams Fellow at Curtin University of Technology for 2008. He was a Founding Director of the ESRC Centre for Research on Innovation and Competition (CRIC) at the University of Manchester and UMIST. Between 1993 and 2008 he was the Stanley Jevons Professor of Political Economy and Cobden Lecturer in the School of Social Sciences at Manchester University. During this period he served terms as Dean of the Faculty of Social and Economic Sciences, and as Interim Dean of the Faculty of Medical and Human Sciences. His research interests are theoretical and empirical and focus on evolutionary economics, innovation systems and processes, and the history of technology and the growth of knowledge, most recently in relation to medical innovation.

During his career he had extensive experience of working in Whitehall. He was a member of the Advisory Council on Applied Research Development (ACARD) from 1984 – 1987 and of the Advisory Council for Science and Technology (ACOST) from 1987 to 1993. He was a member of the Monopolies and Mergers Commission from October 1991 to October 1997. He was a member of the Expert Group on Knowledge for Growth (K4G), advising the European Commissioner for Research from January 2007 until its work was completed in 2009.

He is a past President of the International Schumpeter Society (1998-2000), the Manchester Statistical Society (1992-1994), and of Section F (Economics) of the British Association for the Advancement of Science (2008). He has published over 150 papers and books. Invited, distinguished lectures include the Momigliano lecture, (University of Rome 2004), the Colin Clark Lecture (University of Queensland, 2005), the Presidential Address to Section F of the British Association for the Advancement of Science (2008), the Haydn Williams Lecture (Curtin University of Technology, 2008), The Swedish Schumpeter lecture (University of Gothenburg, 2022).
