I have six years of academic and research experience in international law, comprising three years as a postdoctoral research fellow and three years as a PhD candidate. My work has primarily focused on international human rights law, climate change law, and disaster risk management. I am currently finalising a monograph on these topics, which is under contract with Springer Nature. My research is particularly centred on human rights-based climate change litigation, supported by active collaborations with international research networks. At the Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies, I have contributed to research and teaching activities, collaborating with international universities and engaging with a diverse community of students. I have also undertaken significant periods abroad as a visiting researcher and trainee. Previously, I served as a research assistant to a member of the International Law Commission and Special Rapporteur on the "Protection of Persons in the Event of Disasters". Additionally, I worked as a Blue Book Trainee at DG ECHO (European Commission), where I contributed to the implementation of the rescEU initiative.


