Scheduling of the applicant's hearings on the basis of the magistrate's decision and organization of cultural mediators: as a support tool, the research officer has created an excel file for the management of all the hearings scheduled by the specialized section by entering the hearing date and the languages spoken by the applicant. The file is made up of special formulas that automatically highlight the common languages of the applicants so as to simplify the scheduling of hearings and the use of cultural mediators.
3. COI (Country of Origin Information) researches: the research officer carries out COI research-following the EASO methodology-on the country of origin of the applicant for international protection, following the formulation of the question by the magistrate, also for the purpose of external credibility analysis.
4. Case law and doctrine searches: Jurisprudential research on themes and issues indicated by the judge. The research officer will be able to examine both national jurisprudence (referring both to the legitimacy and to the merit) and the decisions made by supranational courts (specifically, the European Court of Human Rights and the Court of Justice of the European Union).
5. Preliminary activities for dispute resolution
6. Cross-cutting activities: direct communication with the Court Registry; operations on the Magistrate's Console, assistant function; organization of workshops and meetings within the same section dedicated to the deepening of the COI issue, addressed to judges and staff of the specialized sections, also in line with what is contained in the EASO Judicial practical guide on country of origin information, during which illustrate the EASO methodology on the subject.

Once the study of the dossier has been completed, drafting of summary reports to be submitted to the magistrate, in which the events are summarized, critical points and points to be examined in depth at the hearing and any other remarks are reported. In the study of the file, the research officer also analyzes the case law precedents of the section that may be relevant to the decision of the case.

For the Milan's Community Center, I managed a project devoted specifically to support to Dublin cases (transfers between EU Member States under EU Regulation 604/13), in direct collaboration with the Prefecture of Varese, border police and the foreigners' desk at the border crossing point of the Milano Malpensa airport. Starting mid-February 2020, I have become coordinator for the foreigner and asylum desk at the border crossing point of Malpensa International Airport, on behalf of the Prefecture of Varese. As project coordinator, I was in charge of supervising the assessment of vulnerable complex cases, the evaluation and support to the admission in the public reception system, as well as the management of project budget, reporting and periodic follow-up for the Prefecture of Varese and, upon request, for UNHCR.

I worked within the reception system of the CAS SPRAR/SIPROIMI and the "Humanitarian Corridors" project of Mediterranean Hope, taking care of the daily legal management of asylum seekers and holders of protection hosted in the projects: verbalization of the request for protection, preparation for the hearing in front of the Territorial Commission through an in-depth collection of personal history and research of COI, access and interactions with the Police Headquarters and Prefecture, support to lawyers in case of litigation, management of immigration law cases such as family reunification, marriage, labour exploitation and trafficking. In addition to the tasks on site in Milan, I also provided consultancy and legal support to other teams of CSD Diaconia Valdese present throughout Italian territory, in the management of more complex cases. All this requires constant interaction with the different territorial stakeholders and institutions such as the Police Immigration offices, Prefectures, the Central Service of SIPROIMI, UNHCR and IOM for their respective competence profiles. Since 2017, I had a great deal of cooperation with IOM's territorial referents, especially with the ADITUS project, in regard of the handling of vulnerable cases of trafficking and labour exploitation, by carrying out joint talks as well as by activating various joint information sessions between IOM's territorial referents in Lombardy, the team and the beneficiaries of the CAS and SPRAR/SIPROIMI reception projects. As far as the beneficiaries of the SPRAR/SIPROIMI project are concerned, it was no longer a matter of working in the procedure for the recognition of international protection, but rather of immigration law, in fact I am following cases of family reunification, conversion of residence permit from protection to work and/or study, various types of marriage (e.g. by proxy, with an asylum seeker, with an Italian citizen and with another status holder residing in a different EU Member State).
