Arturo Marzano (Rome, 1973) is Associate Professor of History of the Middle East at the Department of Civilization and Forms of Knowledge, University of Pisa.

He got his PhD in Contemporary History at the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna, Pisa, and has been Post-doc Research Fellow at the International Institute for Holocaust Research - *Yad Vashem*, Jerusalem; Research Fellow at the University of Pisa; Senior Research Fellow at the Université Panthéon-Assas (Paris 2); Marie Curie Fellow at the European University Institute; Visiting Researcher at the Hebrew University, Jerusalem, and at the American University Beirut.

His research mainly deals with history of Judaism, Zionism, the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and the relationship between Italy and the Middle East in the XX century.

The Israeli-Palestinian Conflict and Italy], Roma, 2013. With Marcella Simoni he has edited the volumes Quaranta anni dopo. Confini, barriere e limiti in Israele e Palestina (1967-2007) [Forty Years Later. Borders, Barriers and Limits in Israel and Palestine (1967-2007)], Bologna, 2007; and Roma e Gerusalemme. Israele nella vita politica e culturale italiana (1949-2009) [Rome and Jerusalem. Israel in the Italian Political and Cultural Life (1949-2009)], Genova, 2010. With Serena Di Nepi he has edited in 2013 the special issue Travels to the "Holy Land". Perceptions, Representations and Narratives of the on-line Journal Quest. Issues in Contemporary Jewish History (http://www.questcdecjournal.it). With Adriano Roccucci, he has edited in 2022 the special issue Città sacre in età contemporanea [Sacred Cities in Modern History] of the journal «Memoria e Ricerche».

He has published articles in leading Italian and International journals, including Contemporanea, Passato e Presente, The Journal of Conflict Studies, European Journal of Jewish Studies, Israel Studies, The International Spectator, Journal of Modern Jewish Studies.
