I am Full Professor in the Department of Politics and Administration at the Universidad Complutense de Madrid (Spain). I currently teach Gender and Politics and Public Policies courses to undergraduate and postgraduate students. I achieved my PhD in Politics at the *University of Reading* (UK) and my research focuses on Gender and Politics (gender equality policies, Europeanization, feminism and democracy). I have enjoyed four competitive postdoctoral research contracts (Ramón y Cajal 2006-2011; Postdoctoral researcher Radboud University Nijmegen 2006; Senior researcher EC grant 2003-2005; Spanish Ministry of Education postdoctoral researcher 2002-2003) and I have been visiting professor at the universities of Antwerp, Madison-Wisconsin, Helsinki, Aalborg, Institute for Human Sciences in Vienna, and Scuola Normale Superiore in Florence. I am currently PI of one WP and of the UCM team in the Horizon Europe [CCINDLE](#) project (2022-2026), have directed as PI the research project funded by the European Commission TARGET, I have co-directed as PI the Spanish research Project [UNIGUAL](#) with Maria Bustelo, and I have participated in five research projects funded by the European Commission (QUING, MAGEEQ, UniSafe, CIDEL, EURCIT) and four Spanish national research projects on gender equality policies and European citizenship. I have published over a hundred academic works, between articles in indexed impact journals such as *Policy & Politics*, *European Journal of Political Research*, *Journal of Common Market Studies*, *Policy & Society*, *Social Politics*, *South European Society and Politics* (see Researcher ID: W-4938-2017; Orcid.org/0000-0001-7644-6891), chapters, including for Oxford University Press Handbooks, and books. The three monographs I have written are *Gender and Political Analysis* (Palgrave 2017 with Johanna Kantola), *The Symbolic Representation of Gender* (Routledge 2014 with Petra Meier) and *The Europeanization of Spanish gender equality policy* (Tirant 2004). I have edited the special issues Gender Inequalities in Academia (*Sociology of Work* 2024 with Manuela Naldini & Barbara Poggio), De-democratization and opposition to gender equality politics in Europe (*Social Politics* 2021 with Johanna Kantola & Ruth Rubio), Populism and Feminist Politics (*International Political Science Review* 2020, with Johanna Kantola), Care policies in practice (*Policy and Society* 28, 4, 2019, with Rossella Ciccio) and Policymaking from a Gender+ Equality Perspective (*Journal of Women, Politics and Policy*, 38, 1, 2017, with Petra Meier & Mieke Verloo).
