Who can vote?

- Research Fellows at the Telecommunications, Computer Engineering, and Photonics Institute
- PhD Students enrolled in “Emerging Digital Technologies” Course, during its legal duration - Curricula:
 - *Embedded Systems, focused on design and development of software for real-time embedded systems;*
 - *Photonic Technologies focused on photonic integrated circuits, sensors, photonic communications and telecommunications networks;*
- The Administrative and Technical staff of Telecommunications, Computer Engineering, and Photonics Institute.

When can you vote?

The election will take place as follows:

1. first round: **11-12 July 2022** (from 9:00 a.m. on 11 July 2022 to 12 a.m. on 12 July 2022)
2. second round, if any: **13-14 July 2022** (from 9:00 a.m. on 13 July 2022 to 12 a.m. on 14 July 2022)

How can you vote?

How many preferences can you express?

Each voter can express one preference only.

Which is the election quorum?

- ✓ first round: the absolute majority of those entitled to vote per each category
- ✓ second round, if any: 1/3 of those entitled to vote per each category
- ✓ third round, if any: no quorum

Who is elected?

For each category, the one who obtains the highest number of votes validly cast is elected.
