MINUTE OF THE PRELIMINARY MEETING

The Evaluation Committee for the selection of one tenure-track – probationary assistant professor (ricercatore a tempo determinato) for the Academic Recruitment Field *International and EU Law* (SC 12/E1) at the Academic Class of Social Sciences and the DIRPOLIS Institute of the Scuola Superiore di Studi Universitari e di Perfezionamento Sant’Anna di Pisa/Sant’Anna School of Advanced Studies, Pisa pursuant to Italian Law No. 240/2010, Art. 24 paragraph 3 letter B- appointed by decree No. 235 of April 19, 2022 of the Rector, consists of:

The Committee convened for the first time, via teleconference, on June 21, 2022, at 08, 30, from the following locations:

Prof. Maja SERŠIĆ was nominated as Chairperson and Prof. Andreas de GUTTRY was nominated as Secretary.

Pursuant to Art. 5 paragraph 2 of Legislative Decree No. 1172/1948, each member declared to have no kinship or affinity up to the fourth grade with any of the other members and that there are not reasons for abstention in relation to art. 51 of the Italian Code of Civil procedure.

The Committee reviewed the call (published on the School website) as well as the Regulations of the School regarding the recruitment for tenure-track – probationary, assistant professors (Art. 24 paragraph 3 letter B).

The Committee then decided that the Committee's work should terminate by September 20, 2022.

The Committee ascertained that the Human Resources Area communicated that six applications have been received, whereby all the candidates have been admitted to the selection.

The selection will be effected by means of a public interview about the qualifications and the publications of the applicants. During the public interview, the Committee will also assess the level of knowledge of the English language.

After the public interview, the Committee will attribute a score to the qualifications, to every publication submitted and to the overall scientific production (including the research project) of the candidates, according to the parameters established by Ministerial Decree 243/2011 and to the criteria assessed in the present meeting.

The winner will be declared on the basis of the score obtained.

The Committee decided the criteria for the score attribution to the qualifications, to every publication submitted and to the overall scientific of the candidates, according to the parameters established by Ministerial Decree 243/2011 and taking into account the minimum score for the proper assessment.

The Committee will assign a maximum score of 100/100 allocated as follows:

QUALIFICATIONS - maximum score of 40, allocated as follows:

- a) PhD or equivalent, awarded in Italy or abroad: up to: 4
- b) teaching activities at university level in Italy or abroad: up to: 8
- c) documented training or research activities carried out in qualified institutes in Italy or abroad: up to: 4
- d) project activities as regards the academic recruitment fields where applicable: up to: 6
- e) organization, management and coordination in national and international research groups: up to: 5
- f) participation – in national and international research groups: up to 3
- g) participation as a speaker in international conferences: up to: 3
- h) participation as a speaker in national conferences: up to: 3
- g) national and international awards for research activities: up to: 4

The Committee will assign a score to each abovementioned item in relation to its significance in terms of quantity and quality of the research activities carried out by each candidate.

PUBLICATIONS - maximum score of 40:

Publications will be assessed along with texts accepted for publication in accordance with regulations as well as the essays included in collective works and articles published in journals in paper or digital format, with the exception of internal notes or departmental reports; the PhD or equivalent thesis will be assessed too, even though unpublished.

The evaluation of scientific publications will be carried out based on the following additional criteria:

- a) originality, innovation, methodological rigor and relevance of each publication;
- b) coherence of each publication with the academic recruitment field and with the specific profile of the call, or with closely related interdisciplinary subjects;
- c) scientific relevance of each journal / publisher.

The Committee, balancing the scores, in the case of works carried out in partnership, shall pay particular attention to the individual contribution of the researcher, considered also in terms of originality, innovation, methodological rigor and relevance of each publication.

The Committee will assign the following scores to each of the submitted publications:

- a) Monographs and edited volumes: up to 10 (maximum score for this item: 20)
- b) Articles in Journals of international reputation: up to 8
- c) Articles in Journals of national reputation: up to 6
- d) Book chapters and encyclopaedia chapters: up to 4.

The Committee decides to use the standardisation approach about the scientific production as compared to the academic age of the applicants, providing this method of calculation: the reference year T is the year of the first publication. To this end, the Committee will use the following formula:
 $AA = (2022 - T) + 1$.

OVERALL CONSISTENCY OF THE SCIENTIFIC PRODUCTION - maximum score 20.

The Committee shall also assess the overall consistency of the scientific production of the researcher, the intensity and the temporal continuity of such production, with the exception of periods of involuntary removal from the research with particular reference to parental functions – such periods should be adequately documented.

In order to be eligible for the position, the applicants shall score a number of points equal or higher than 60.

The Committee decided that the maximum duration of the public interview with every candidate shall not exceed 30 minutes; for the assessment of the level of knowledge of the English language, the interview will be conducted in English.

The Committee decided that the interview will be on September 13, at 14, 00 and that the list of the admitted candidates will be published on the web site of the School on July 20, 2022 as stated in the Call.

The Committee decided to reconvene on June 24, at 08, 00 am in order to know the list of the candidates.

At the end of the meeting, the Committee decided that the Secretary will send a signed copy of these agreed minutes to Staff Office, together with the declarations of approval by the other members of the Committee. These declarations form an integral part of these agreed minutes.

The meeting was adjourned at 09, 15 am
