

**Id 3616 - CALL: CLIMATE ETHICS AND INTERGENERATIONAL JUSTICE: PROFILE A) GROUNDING INTERGENERATIONAL JUSTICE: RESHAPING THE QUESTION ON RECIPROCITY AMONG SUBJECTS AND GENERATIONS; PROFILE B) GROUNDING CLIMATE ETHICS: MOTIVATIONAL MODELS TOWARDS CLIMATE-CHANGE-SENSITIVE BEHAVIOURS**

**Position and grant**

Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna announces a call to assign two Research Fellowships to perform research activities related to the scientific field M-FIL/03 – Moral Philosophy at the Institute of law, politics and development. The gross amount of the fellowship is 20.267,00 €per year. The present fellowship cannot be cumulated with other fellowships and grants except those aimed at financing a period of stay abroad necessary within the research activity. The duration of the research fellowship is 12 months, renewable in case of positive evaluation of the research activities performed.

**Research Activity**

- **Research title** “Climate ethics and Intergenerational Justice: Profile a) Grounding Intergenerational Justice: Reshaping the question on reciprocity among subjects and generations; Profile b) Grounding Climate Ethics: Motivational models towards climate-change-sensitive behaviours.”
- **Research description** “Description of the research: the activities related to the object of this procedure are part of the research area in Ethics and Global Challenges at the Institute of Law, Politics and Development of the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna. They are part of the PRO3 project "Theories and tools for the ecological transition: philosophical, mathematical, ethical and legal profiles related to the carbon budget sustainability challenge". We intend to recruit two research profiles on related but distinct topics. The first profile is summarized by the title: On the foundation of intergenerational justice: redefining the question of reciprocity between subjects and generations. The candidate must demonstrate that she possesses solid skills in moral philosophy, with reference to the current debates on the theories of justice, of intergenerational justice, and of climate change. Specific attention will be given to the theme of reciprocity (direct and indirect) between subjects and generations. With respect to the second profile - Grounding Climate Ethics: Motivational models towards climate-change-sensitive behaviours - the candidate must demonstrate that she possesses solid skills in moral philosophy, with particular reference to climate ethics, theories of action and moral motivation, moral and behavioral psychology. Both profiles also require strong organizational skills, together with a significant ability to process individual and team research and to produce a significant number of papers for publications (single- or multi-author) of high international standing. Excellent interpersonal communication skills, proactive attitude and enthusiasm to work on impact-driven research, together with excellent command of English are also required.”

**Admission Requirements**

Applicants must hold a master’s Degree in Philosophy, Political Sciences or International Relations.

The candidate must indicate his/her status, personal information and qualities in the curriculum vitae. Particularly, he/she must also analytically indicate studies completed, qualifications earned, publications and/or patents, services provided, functions performed, the positions held and any other scientific, professional and educational activities that may have been performed, listing exact references for each qualification indicated.

Academic and professional qualifications must be self-certified by the form at Attachment B or submitted in copy accompanied by a declaration of conformity to the original, pursuant to Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28 December 2000, using the form at Attachment C. Other qualifications, theses and/or publications may be submitted in their original form or in copy accompanied by the declaration in lieu of notarized affidavit using the form at Attachment C.

## Selection method and ranking list

The selection is based on the assessment of qualifications and an interview for a total of 100 points, of which **65** points are for the assessment of qualifications and **35** points are for the interview.

### Assessment of qualifications:

- 1) Academic qualifications: **25** points
  - Achievement and / or attendance of a PhD in a subject relevant to the research topics of the present call: **15** points
  - Attendance of post-graduate courses or training courses in subjects related to the research topics of this call: **5** points
  - Other qualifications: **5** points
- 2) Publications and original works according to their relevance and importance: **20** points
- 3) Research activity in public or private bodies with contracts, research grants, scholarships, post-doctoral scholarships, both in Italy and abroad related to the topics covered by the call: **20** points

The candidate will be admitted to the interview if he/she obtains at least 45 points in the evaluation of the titles and will pass the interview obtaining at least 20 points.

A ranking list of eligible candidates will be drawn up by the examination committee at the end of the selection.

Interview: 10/02/2023, 14:30, p.m. (CET)

Resident abroad applicants may also ask to hold their interview in their country of residence via conference call. In this case the candidate is asked to contact Italian Embassies or his/her local University, arranging the interview for the date scheduled and considering that he/she will be previously identified by an employee or a Professor.

**Formalization of the fellowship and contract termination**

Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna will contact the winner at the email address provided for the selection, offering him/her the fellowship and asking to reply before the beginning of the fellowship.
