

Summary of the Rector's Decree n. o224 of March, 29, 2023

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR no. THREE TENURE TRACK - PROBATIONARY ASSISTANT PROFESSOR POSITIONS

The Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies - Pisa (Sant'Anna School) announces a call for the recruitment of **three tenure-track – probationary, assistant professors** (ricercatori a tempo determinato) with full time temporary contract pursuant to Italian Law no. 240/2010, art. 24 paragraph 3 letter B at various Institutes of the Sant'Anna School:

Academic Faculty of Social Sciences

INSTITUTE OF LAW, POLITICS AND DEVELOPMENT (DIRPOLIS)

- One position in the Academic Recruitment Field "Comparative Law" (SC 12/E2)
 - Academic Discipline "Comparative Private Law" (SSD IUS/02)

The successful applicant will be required to develop a high impact publications plan and an independent and externally funded applied research program, contribute to the ongoing research and life-long training programmes at least in Italian, English, and French. He/she will be also required to actively contribute to the life of the Institute and the Scuola Sant'Anna including teach, advise and mentor undergraduate and graduate students and contribute to the Third Mission activities.

Research activities should focus on the following domains: data governance and civil protection of fundamental rights; fundamental rights protection with reference also to vulnerable subjects in the digital era and their personal data; civil liability in general and with specific reference to the digital domain, as well as in connection with activities (digital and not) in the family spheres or with reference to vulnerable individuals; technology regulation with particular but not exclusive reference to data mining, artificial intelligence.

The successful candidate she will be also required to actively contribute to the life of the Institute and the Scuola Sant'Anna including teach, advise and mentor undergraduate and graduate students and contribute to the Third Mission activities.

Candidates can submit no more than 15 publications.

One position in the Academic Recruitment Field "Political Science" (SC 14/A2)
- Academic Discipline "Political Science" (SSD SPS/04)

Research activities will contribute to the security and conflict studies agenda developed by international relations team of the Scuola Sant'Anna:

They will focus on security and governance with reference to high fragility, instability contexts, transnational violent dynamics (armed conflicts, terrorism, organized crime) border and migration-related issues and climate change challenges. The aforementioned activities must be focused on one or more of the following geographical regions: West Africa (Sahel), Mediterranean/Middle East (MENA), Eastern Europe (potentially including the role of the European Union in these regions).

The successful candidate will develop a research program that contributes to ongoing activities also through external funding, and will propose a high-impact publication plan, in Italian, English and/or French. S/he will actively contribute to the academic life of the Institute and the Scuola Sant'Anna, including teaching, advising, and tutoring undergraduate and graduate students, as well as 'Third mission' activities.



Candidates can submit no more than 15 publications.

 One position in the Academic Recruitment Field "Experimental Physics of Matter" (SC 02/B1) – Academic Discipline "Physics of Matter" (SSD FIS/03)

The selected candidate will perform research activities on "Development of advances photonic sensors, based on discrete components as well as on photonic integration, and their integration in smart materials to provide integrated sensing solutions in a wide range of industrial fields including energy, automotive, transportation and aerospace applications. Also chemical, environmental and biomedical photonic sensors will be studied". The selected candidate will also be involved in teaching activities within the PhD and Master courses of the IIM Institute and within undergraduate courses at Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna.

Candidates can submit no more than 12 publications.

The assistant professors will contribute to teaching activities within the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna teaching programs (Undergraduate, Master, Seasonal Schools and And Ph.D. students), also delivered in English.

Duration of the contracts: three years.

<u>Terms and conditions of employment</u>: in his third year Assistant Professors who have received from Italian Ministry of University and Research, the appropriate qualification ("abilitazione") and eligibility for promotion, according to Law no. 240/2010, art. 16, at the rank of Associate Professor or higher, will be evaluated by Sant'Anna School Committee, pursuant Ministerial Decree no. 344/2011, for possible promotion to tenured positions by the end of that period.

Salary: 44.208 € gross per year

Admission Requirements:

Candidates must satisfy the following requirements:

• to hold a PhD or equivalent. If the PhD degree or equivalent qualification has been awarded abroad, candidates must provide the documents which certify that these qualifications are considered equivalent according to the Italian law in force (equipollence/equivalence-recognition of degrees). If candidates do not comply with the requirement while submitting the application, they will be admitted to the selection under condition and, if winners, they have to submit all necessary documents certifying that their qualifications are considered equivalent according to the Italian law in force by the date of the signature of the contract¹.

- to have achieved the Italian appropriate qualification ("abilitazione nazionale") received by the Ministry of University and Research, according to art. 16 of Law no. 240/2010, at the rank of Associate or Ordinary Professor or to have been employed for at least three years, even if not consecutive, as non tenured assistant professor or as research fellow or as postdoctoral fellow. The contracts, if obtained by Italian Universities, must have been subscribed pursuant to art. 1, paragraph 14 of Law 230/2005 or pursuant to art. 24 paragraph 3 letter a) of Law 240/2010 or pursuant to art. 51 paragraph 6 of Law 449/97 and amendments or pursuant art. 22 of law 240/2010 or pursuant to art. 4 of Law 398/89. Validity and equivalence requirements of contracts obtained by non-Italian Universities will be evaluated by Sant'Anna School Evaluation Committee;
- to have an excellent knowledge of both written and spoken English.

Who Can't Apply

- Those who, at the date of the deadline for application, are or have been professors or assistant professors who achieved tenure.
- Those Who, at the date of the application deadline, are related, within the fourth degree, by blood or by marriage to professors of Sant'Anna School, or to the Rector (Rettore) or to the Managing Director (Direttore Generale), or to a member of the Board of Directors (Consiglio di Amministrazione) of Sant'Anna School.

To apply candidates need have a mail address, a printer and a scanner because they have to print, sign and upload the scanned copy of the application.

They will be able to withdraw their application until the deadline, ld they need to change a submitted application, they have to withdraw it and submit a new one.



Selection process and calendar:

The evaluation committee will be appointed by the Rector of the Scuola Sant'Anna. A restricted number of applicants, to be admitted to a final interview, will be selected by the committee, on the basis of cv's, publications and qualifications.
