

### **CALL FOR ONE TECHNOLOGY EXPERT**

Institute of Mechanical Intelligence Sant'Anna School for Advanced Studies – Pisa

### **Job Position**

The Sant'Anna School for Advanced Studies announces a public selection call based on qualifications and competitive exams for recruiting one technical staff member. The contract will run for 24 months, with placement in D grade, economic position D3, at the Institute of Mechanical Intelligence of Sant'Anna School for Advanced Studies. This role will provide technical support to the project: "BRIEF - Biorobotics Research and Innovation Engineering Facilities", funded through the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR), supported by the European NextGenerationEU programme.

### Main duties and activities

As part of the research activities of the project, the School needs a professional figure able to provide both administrative and technical support.

In particular, the figure being sought shall have the following knowledge and skills:

- Designing and manufacturing of analog and digital electronic circuits.
- CAD tools for circuit design.
- Programming of mechatronic and automation systems.
- Development and design of electronic devices for high voltage control, monitoring and measurement.

Moreover, the figure being sought will carry out the following activities:

- Implementation, management and maintenance of the equipment of the LEAST (Large Scale Electrostatic Actuators and Energy Harvesters) laboratory.
- Design and development of testing machines for HV electrostatic devices.
- Development of procedures for the characterization and testing of transducers.
- Design and implementation of electronic circuits for the driving and control of HV electrostatic devices.

### **Admission Requirements**

Applicants must hold:

- Bachelor's or Master's degree in Electronic Engineering or Information Engineering.
- At least two years (also if not continuous) of documented job experience in pertinent fields.
- Excellent knowledge of both English and Italian.









- In order to work in Italy as public employees, <u>non-EU citizens</u> need a long-term residence permit or the status of refugee or otherwise in need of international protection, i.e. the subsidiary protection status pursuant to Legislative Decree n° 251/2007 or the status of family member of the holder of subsidiary protection status present in the Italian national territory pursuant to art. 22, paragraphs 2 and 3 of Legislative Decree n° 251/2007 (specifying in the application the relevant residence permit).
