### Job Position

The Sant'Anna School for Advanced Studies announces a public selection call based on qualifications and competitive exams for recruiting one technical staff member. The contract will run for 20 months, with placement in D grade, economic position D7, at the BioRobotics Institute of Sant'Anna School for Advanced Studies. This role will provide technical support to the project: *"BRIEF - Biorobotics Research and Innovation Engineering Facilities"*, funded through the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR), supported by the European NextGenerationEU programme.

### Main duties and activities

As part of the research activities of the project, the School needs a professional figure able to provide both administrative and technical support, with particular reference to the installation, starting-up, management and maintenance of mechatronic tools and intelligent machines for medical robotics and submarine robotics applications, providing support during the experimental phases carried out by the academic and researcher staff at the Biorobotics Institute. The figure being sought shall therefore have an advanced knowledge in the use of computer and programs of the suite Office365, for the following purposes:

- cloud data management and integration of mechanical and mechatronic modules, i.e. sensors and actuators, with control units.
- Firmware/software and GUI implementation using programming tools such as LabVIEW, Python and Matlab.
- Data storage, sharing and program versioning.
- Management of laboratory activities on electronic, computer and mechatronic systems.

### Admission Requirements

Applicants must hold:

- Bachelor's degree and at least two years (also if not continuous) of documented job experience in pertinent fields
- or Master's degree and at least two years (also if not continuous) of documented job experience in pertinent fields.
- Excellent knowledge of English and good knowledge of Italian.
- In order to work in Italy as public employees, non-EU citizens need a long-term residence permit or the status of refugee or otherwise in need of international protection, i.e. the


