





Responsibilities of beneficiaries of Scholarships funded under DM 117/23

According to Ministerial Decree 117/2023, Ph.D. students awarded these scholarships are required to:

- Comply with the provisions of art. 9 of Reg. (EU) 2021/241 concerning "complementary funding";
- Fulfil the requirements associated with the PNRR measure under which the project is implemented, including:
 - Spending a term abroad of minimum 6 months, not necessarily consecutive;
 - Spending a term in an organization of minimum 6 months, not necessarily consecutive;
 - Completing six-month activity reports through the appropriate ministerial website;
- Fulfil the transversal principles and compliance of the activities with the relevant EU and national environmental legislation.

The themes of the research projects must concern one of the PNRR areas, namely:

1.Digitalization, innovation, competitiveness, culture and tourism; 2. Green revolution and ecological transition; 3. Infrastructure and sustainable mobility; 4. Education and research; 5. Social, gender and geographical equality; 6. Health

According to DM 118/2023, Ph.D. students awarded "PNRR research" scholarships are required to:

- Comply with the provisions of art. 9 of Reg. (EU) 2021/241 concerning "complementary funding";
- Carry out a research project on topics aimed at bringing significant knowledge development, including applied knowledge, in the areas of interest of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR), in particular:
 - Green Transition, Digital Transformation, Smart, Sustainable and Inclusive Growth, Social and Territorial Cohesion, Health and Economic, Social and Institutional Resilience, Policies for New Generations, Children and Youth
- Fulfil the requirements associated with the PNRR measure under which the project is implemented, including:
 - Spending a term abroad of minimum 6 months, not necessarily consecutive;
 - o Completing six-month activity reports through the appropriate ministerial website;
