The Committee convened for the third time, via teleconference, on July, 10, 2023 at 9 a.m.

The draft of the following minute was agreed on and approved by the members of the Committee.

The President ascertained that all the members of the Committee were present and she declared the session open.

The President took note that no candidates have submitted a waiver to participate in the selection and that each member of the Committee have received the link to access online to the application of the candidates and have examined the documents they have submitted.

At 9.50 the Committee completed the examination of the documents supplied by the candidates and ascertained that no 3 candidates are present.

The President informs the candidates that the interview will be held in alphabetic order and identifies the candidates (identification form is Annex 2 to these minutes).

The Committee notes that in addition to the candidates, other interested parties are not present.

Dr. Denise Amram is presently a type A (law 240/2010) researcher at the Dirpolis Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna Institute and previously was an affiliated researcher with the position of data protection officer ex art. 37 EU Reg. 679/2016. She received her PhD degree in "Persons and Legal Protections" (curriculum: Human Person, Civil Liability and Contracts - IUS/01, IUS/02) from Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna in 2012. In addition, she has held a number of fellowships (Erasmus Visiting Fellowship at Utrecht University; POR Visiting Fellowship at Columbia University; Postgraduate Fellowship at Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna) and Research Fellowship in the scientific disciplinary field IUS/02 (from 1.04.2014 to 31.08.2021). The candidate - in addition to conducting two seminars as part of the PhD program in "European Union Law and National Systems" at the University of Ferrara and two seminars at the University of Malta (as well as obtaining numerous lectures in higher education courses scarcely congruent with ssd. IUS/02) - she also obtained the tenure of two teaching modules (12 hours) respectively in: 1) "Responsabilité civile Comparée" at the Panthéon-Assas University and 2) PhD in European and Comparative Law at the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna. The candidate also obtained an official course at LUISS in Rome ("Marketing law and regulation"). Dr. Amram is the coordinator of the research line aimed at investigating the impact of the information society on research (for both experimental and social sciences) ETHOS and ODP at LIDER Lab Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna and participates in numerous national and international research groups. She is PI for legal and ethical profiles for SSSA in the Horizon Europe SMAUG project. She coordinates other research activities including for the Italian Cancer Institute. Finally, the CV shows that Dr. Amram has participated (as a speaker) in numerous conferences although she has presented a more limited number of them in her titles. Dr. Amram's curriculum vitae attests that she is the author of numerous publications. In particular, Dr. Amram has produced 15 publications (distributed as follows: 1 monograph, 8 journal articles, and 6 essays) that denote a relevant background in domestic and comparative law, and a secure methodological training in comparative law. The scientific production submitted for evaluation focuses on three main macro-themes: the person in the family context, the protection of confidentiality with respect to the dissemination of personal data and technological challenges, with respect to which one appreciates not only maturity in method and results, but also originality and adherence to the themes required by the call for papers. We would also like to highlight how the scientific relevance of the editorial placement of the works produced is valuable as well as the presence of contributions in languages (English and French) that emphasize the openness to international dialogue.

Lively participation in comparative conferences as a speaker (subject to evaluation in the titles). In this perspective, it is necessary to point out how the scientific production presented, well placed from an editorial point of view, while revolving around the macro-theme of colonialism/post-colonialism, is complemented by appreciable sorties on the themes of artificial intelligence, religious freedom, domain names system and guaranteed minimum income, thus ensuring to his scientific profile interesting insights of critical reflection and originality.

Dr. [redacted] was awarded a research grant (Research Grant N° 3190236, National Fund for Scientific and Technological Development (FONDECYT), Chile 3 years, ca EUR 100,000). She has been offering courses and seminars in several universities (Otto-von-Guericke Universität Magdeburg, Department of Political Science, Bachelor course in Public International Law at University of Copenhagen). It is evident from Dr. [redacted] s curriculum that she authored numerous publications mainly ascribable to SSD IUS/02. She has produced 14 publications (distributed as follows: 1 monograph, 8 articles in journals and 5 essays). They are mostly axed on the general perception of European private law and extensively focusing on consumer law and housing. The produced publications denote a visible knowledge of comparative methodology. It is important to notice that a minor part of the scientific production presented replicates topics and content internally. The overall scientific profile offers interesting insights, critical theoretical reflections and originality.
