

MASTER IN HUMAN RIGHTS AND CONFLICT MANAGEMENT

The Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna is a public, special statute University which has acquired a significant experience in organizing advanced training courses for professionals engaged in humanitarian assistance and peacekeeping operations.

The Scuola is also particularly active in conducting state-of-the-art research on the protection of human rights in emergency contexts.

DESCRIPTION

The MHRCM is designed to provide students from different cultures and back-grounds with a deep understanding of the linkages between human rights and conflict management theory and practice.

The curriculum, strongly field-oriented, prepares participants to work with NGOs, governmental aid agencies, the UN system and regional organisations, as well as to operate in the context of complex emergencies.

STRUCTURE

- One-year post-graduate master's programme (1st Level)
- Start on January 08, 2025
- About 450 hours of lectures (residential phase in Pisa January-July 2025)
- 480 hours of Internship
- Up to 66 academic credits awarded upon successful competion of the programme



WHO CAN APPLY

The MHRCM is open to a maximum of 28 participants, which must meet the following requirements:

- hold at least a three-year university degree or equivalent (students expecting to graduate before 31 December 2024 are also eligible);
- understand, speak and write English at least at B2 LEVEL.

TUITION FEES AND FACILITIES

- The master costs 7.500 €, payable in two installments.
- Early bird discount: -1.000 € for applications received in the 1st round of selection.
- The tuition fee covers attendance costs, didactic material (in electronic format), tutorship, lunch (on class days), access to all facilities of the Scuola. It does not include accommodation costs in Pisa and during the internship, nor travel or visa-related costs.

PARTIAL TUITION FEE WAIVERS

A limited number of partial waivers will be made available to selected candidates coming from non-OECD countries.

Candidates may apply for the partial waiver by motivating their request in detail in their application.
