

Election of the Director of the Institute

The Director will be elected among Full Professors (working full-time) who present their candidacy by November 18, 2017. Candidates will present their programme in an assembly open to all voters.

Who can vote?

- Full Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors with a permanent contract at the Institute of Economics (voting weight equal to 60%)
- Assistant Professors with a short-term contract and Research Fellows at the Institute of Economics (voting weight equal to 20%)
- Administrative and Technical staff of the Institute of Economics (voting weight equal to 10%)
- PhD Students at the Institute of Economics (voting weight equal to 10%)

The deliberation to call the elections issued on November 7, 2017 establishes that the elections (electronic voting) will take place as follows:

- first round: December 11-12, 2017 (from 9 a.m. of December 11 to 12 a.m. of December 12)
- second round, if any: December 13, 2017 (from 9 a.m. to 12 a.m.)
- third round, if any: December 14, 2017 (from 9 a.m. to 12 a.m.)

Quorum:

- **first round: the absolute majority of those entitled to vote.** The candidate obtaining the relative majority of the weighted votes validly cast is elected.
- second round: at least one-third (1/3) of those entitled to vote. The candidate obtaining the relative majority of the weighted votes validly cast is elected.
- **third round: no quorum is required**. The candidate obtaining the relative majority of the weighted votes validly cast is elected.

The elected Director will remain in office for the academic years 2017/2018 – 2018/2019 – 2019/2020 and can be re-elected only once.
