WHO CAN APPLY

The Master is a competitive programme open to a maximum of 28 candidates.

8 places out of 28 are reserved for non EU candidates. Candidates must meet the following minimum requirements:

- (1) Have an (at least) three-year university degree or equivalent. Students expecting to graduate before December 31, 2018 are also eligible.
- (2) Understand, speak and write **English** at least at LEVEL B2, (CEFR for Languages, CoE).

It does not include accommodation costs in Pisa and during the internship, nor travel or visa-related costs.

Master in Human Rights and Conflict Management

DESCRIPTION

The Master in Human Rights and Conflict Management is designed to provide students from different cultures and backgrounds with a deep understanding of the linkages between human rights and conflict management theory and practice. The curriculum, strongly field oriented, prepares participants to work with NGOs. governments, aid agencies, the UN system and regional organisations, as well as to operate in the context of complex emergencies and joint operations.

STRUCTURE

The Master is a one-year post-graduate programme. It starts on January 14, 2019 and runs until Spring 2020. The Programme encompasses about 400 hours of classroom lectures and 480 hours of internship, in addition to individual studying and to the preparation of a written thesis. Classroom lectures are usually from Monday to Friday and run from January 2019 to the end of July 2019. The internship lasts three or more months, starting from August/September 2019.
